Working with a talk partner that we have not necessarily chosen ourselves

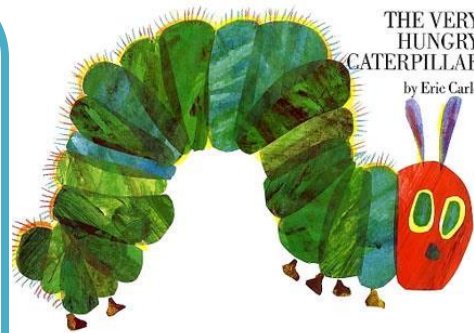
Thinking about our audience and keeping them engaged when presenting our photos as Focus pupil or talking to the class

## **Literacy:**
