<b>What are our needs?</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. To inspire pupils to want to be physically active and continue to increase the levels of physical activity for all children.</li><li>2. Maintain the good standards of PE lessons and after school clubs so that children are better prepared to reach their potential.</li><li>3. To ensure that this is sustainable by developing our own St Matthew's PE specialist.</li><li>4. Increase the breadth of the curriculum so that children have access to a wider range of sports and to ensure that children are challenged appropriately.</li><li>5. Increase opportunities for competitive sports by entering more teams at competitions, allowing more children to participate.</li><li>6. Engage parents with our school PE curriculum, so that children's passions and interests can be continued at home.</li></ol>
