


Candlemas 2018

Below you can see the Year 5 topic umbrella for the Candlemas term. Our topic is 'The Titanic' and you can see how the different subjects link together under a common history topic. (Maths and some other subjects have not been included because curriculum requirements mean that they are usually taught as separate subjects.)

Children will be given the opportunity to research and pursue areas of personal interest within the topic and will be encouraged to bring in any relevant artefacts, books or photos etc.



UMBRELLA TOPIC: HISTORY - 'THE TITANIC'

ENGLISH:

We will be writing the follow text types:

- Diary entries in role as passengers on the Titanic.
- Poetry based on the Titanic disaster
- Advertising leaflets to persuade people to travel on the Titanic

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY:

- What is a diorama?
- Could we capture a moment from the Titanic story as a small scale 3D model?

After research and planning, children will work to build a small, detailed model of a scene from the Titanic story.

SCIENCE:

- What properties do different materials have?
- What are reversible and irreversible changes?

Children will look at sorting, classifying and separating materials in different ways. They will look at how materials can change from one state to another and how these changes may be permanent or reversible.

ART & DESIGN:

- What was the 'Art nouveau'?
- How did Art Nouveau influence the design of the Titanic's interior?

Children will look at the 'art nouveau' style- especially posters and adverts from the Edwardian period. They will study and replicate designs using different materials.

HISTORY:

- Why did the Titanic sink?
- What was life like on board the Titanic like?

The children find out about facilities on board the Titanic, why it sank and what happened to different passengers.

LANGUAGES: FRENCH

How to talk about places in my town.

How to direct/guide someone using a map

How to describe where I live.

MUSIC:

- What was Edwardian 'Music hall' music?
- What music was played on the titanic?

The children will listen to Edwardian music hall music and learn some famous songs from the time of the Titanic.
