Key dates

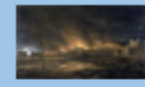
Great Fire of London: 2nd September - 6th September 1666.

The Great Fire of London (1666)

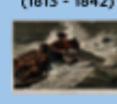

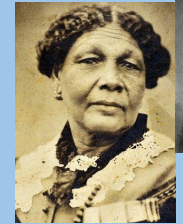
Key People

Mary Seacole - A nurse from Jamaica who built her own hospital during the war.
